

## The Message of Your King and His Kingdom (A Gospel Outline)

- **God**
  - Maker
    - Universe Maker – Made everything that exists (Genesis 1)
    - Man Maker – Made you and me and everyone (Genesis 1)
    - Law Maker – Declares what is morally right and wrong, good and evil, and the consequences for breaking this law. (Exodus 20, Romans 6:23)
  - Holy (Lev 11:24, 1 Peter 1:16, Rev 4:8)
    - Incomprehensibly perfect in every way
- **Man**
  - Made to know God
    - Made to be satisfied by God (John 10:10, Psalm 37:4)
    - Made to worship God (love, service, commitment) (Colossians 1:16-18, Romans 1:25, 11:36)
    - Made to glorify God (magnify God – like a telescope, not a microscope) (1 Peter 4:11)
      - By enjoying Him (his goodness, love and satisfaction in all things and through all things) in this life and the next.
  - Rebelled in SIN (Law breaking rebellion) (Romans 3)
    - Broke God’s law completely (James 2:10)
      - By lying, stealing, adultery (lust), murder (hate), idolatry (priority and valuing of self over all others)
  - Are condemned to eternal punishment and separation from God under God’s right, just, judgment and wrath.
- **Christ**
  - Fully man and Fully God
    - Exercised authority over
      - Nature (winds, seas, etc.) (Mark 4:39)
      - Super-nature (casted out demons) (Mark 1:34)
      - Sickness (Mark 1:34)
      - Death (Mark 5:41)
      - Taught with authority (You have heard, but I tell you) (Matt 5)
      - Sin (forgave Sin)(Mark 2:5)
  - Lived the sinless life I am commanded to live (Hebrews 4:15)
  - Died the sin punishing death I deserved (2 Cor 5:21)
  - Absorbed God’s just wrath in my place (substitution) (1 Pet 3:18)
  - Defeated the power of death by rising again (2 Cor 15, Acts 2:24)
  - Sits at God’s right hand with the power to save or condemn (Acts 2:33)
  - Will return one day to renew and restore all things, save those who have trusted in him, and punish those who have not (2Pet3:13, Rev 19 and 21)
- **Response**
  - Jesus commands all men, everywhere to REPENT and BELIEVE. (Acts 17:30)
    - Repent – turn from loving and worshipping self and rebellion against God toward loving, worshipping, and obeying God
    - Believe – Trust in Jesus Christ’s work on the cross to absorb God’s punishment for your sin. And trust in God’s favor earned for you through Jesus’ life, death, and resurrection (Grace).
  - Reject this command and continue in a path toward hell and eternal punishment and separation from God. (Acts 17:32a)
  - Consider Further (Though still a Rejection, open to talk more) (Acts 17:32b)
  - Repent and Believe and cry out to God for forgiveness, trusting that Christ’s work on the cross was for you! (see Psalm 51 for an example)
    - Continue in a life of Belief and Repentance in the context of a community of faith under qualified leaders/shepherds (church, discipleship)
